General Information

Location

Huntleigh Equestrian Centre 1001 William Mooney Road, Carp (Ottawa), Ontario K0A 1L0
Located minutes from the Queensway in the west end of Ottawa.

Stabling

Limited stabling is available. \$50 for overnight or \$40 for a day stall. Bring your own hay and shavings. Please indicate your stabling requirements on the entry form.

Facilities

Competitors will have access to warm-up areas. Trailer parking is available on site.

Schedule

The show will run in the following order:

- Dressage: upper levels first, progressing to lower levels, followed by Working Equitation Dressage classes
- Working Equitation Ease of Handling classes
- Working Equitation Speed classes

The ride schedule will be emailed to entered competitors and posted to the Huntleigh Equestrian Centre website following the entry deadline. Riders should plan to arrive with adequate warm-up time before their first ride.

Rules & Regulations

Helmets

An ASTM/SEI- or equivalent-certified equestrian helmet with harness properly fastened is mandatory for all mounted activities, including warm-up and on the show grounds. This is a non-negotiable safety rule.

Attire

Clean, neat schooling attire is appropriate. Formal show attire is welcome but not required. Riders are encouraged to wear breeches and tall or paddock boots. Spurs and whips must comply with the applicable test rules.

Equipment & Tack

Dressage classes: Legal dressage saddle, snaffle or double bridle as required by level. Equipment should comply with USDF rules for the applicable test.

Working Equitation classes: Equipment appropriate to the level as outlined by the governing working equitation body. Saddle type (dressage or WE) must be consistent throughout all phases ridden on the same day.

Health Requirements

The following documentation is required for all horses and must be presented upon check-in:

- Current negative Coggins test (Equine Infectious Anemia) – within the past 12 months
- Proof of current vaccination (minimum: Equine Influenza and Equine Herpesvirus)

Horses without proper documentation will not be permitted to compete or remain on the grounds.

Conduct

Competitors, coaches, and guests are expected to treat all officials, volunteers, and fellow competitors with courtesy and respect. Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in elimination and/or exclusion from the grounds.

Liability

Huntleigh Equestrian Centre, show officials, and volunteers assume no responsibility for accidents, injury, loss, or damage to horses, riders, or property. All participants compete at their own risk. A signed liability waiver is required as part of entry submission.

Dressage Classes – USDF Tests

All dressage tests use current USDF test sheets. Riders may enter multiple tests and multiple levels. The same horse and rider combination may enter a maximum of four (4) dressage classes per day.

Test of Choice / Freestyle

Rider must declare the test or freestyle to be ridden at time of entry. Music (if applicable) must be provided to the show secretary by 8:00 a.m. on the day of show.

Working Equitation Classes

Working Equitation (WE) is offered in three phases: Dressage, Ease of Handling, and Speed. Competitors may enter one or more phases at a single level. All phases at the same level must be ridden on the same horse.

Phase 1 – Working Equitation Dressage

Ridden in a dressage arena. Tests reflect the movements and expectations of the competitor's WE level.

Phase 2 – Ease of Handling

Ridden through an obstacle course demonstrating obedience, suppleness, and precision. Obstacles are level-appropriate.

Phase 3 – Speed

Riders complete the same obstacle course as Ease of Handling at speed. Faults are assessed for errors and obstacles not correctly completed.

WE Speed – Level 3	Level 3	WE-SP3	\$30

Level 1 Speed is walk/trot only. A 5-second time penalty will be assessed for each canter break during the round.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 6th, subject to sufficient entries. The show committee reserves the right to combine classes in the event of insufficient entries.

- Champion ribbons and prizes awarded in each division (Dressage and Working Equitation)
- Champion is determined by the highest average percentage across all classes entered in that division (excluding dressage freestyle)
